NOTICE TO PARENTS/ GUARDIANS ATTENDING CAMP WITH THEIR MINOR CHILDREN

Hello to all parents/ guardians/ assigned adults who are attending MFC this summer with their minor-aged children. The Health and Safety team at MFC would like to explain our policies and procedures related to level of supervision of children at our camp.

All minor-aged campers are expected to be in classes during the day. If an absence from class is arranged by the parent with the particular staff instructor, the responsible adult is expected to supervise that camper during that time.

Minor children cannot be unsupervised at MFC. This includes any evening activities, as well. Minor children cannot be left unattended in tents, campers, or cabins while their adults are elsewhere participating in workshops, shows, dances, or other social events. We also ask that older minor-aged campers are NOT asked to watch or supervise younger campers even for short duration.

We ask that minors stay in the direct area campus, near the main dining lodge, and not wander off to tenting areas or various trails. If your children wish to explore, they may do so with a designated adult. Swimming or lake-side presence is only permitted during specified life-guard times.

Minor children attending camp with their parents, must be housed with their parents or guardians, whether in a tent, RV or bunkhouse. If parents desire children to stay in a MFC supervised bunkhouse, there will be an additional fee for this option.
